2. Recognize and color the apples with the number "1" in red




Count the objects inside each frame and trace the numbers. Then, try to "copy" and practice writing the numbers inside the empty boxes provided.



Please draw the same picture next to the original, but change


'the size' of the sun to be 'bigger than' the original picture of the sun, and 'the size' of the moon to be 'smaller than' the original picture of the moon.
