

#1. In this picture, what can you see that starts with the letter 'B' and makes the 'b' sound?

#3. Now, what's the opposite word of the word big'? And what's the opposite word of the word 'small'?




Count the candy corn and then connect each number to the corresponding candy corn using lines.





#1 Let's review the letter 'B.' What words do you know that start with the letter 'B'?




#3 Practice your fine motor skills by tracing the letters. It will be great if you can color the Bat and the letter B b.
